RESIDUAL WASTE BINS



Non-recycleable waste

- Film, photos, slides and CDs
- Dry paintbrushes
- Greasy and dirty paper
- Light bulbs and broken glass
- Sanitary products, e.g. sanitary towels, tampons and paper tissues
- Pottery, stoneware and porcelain
- Leather and soiled textiles
- Mineral cat litter
- Nylons, net curtains
- Vacuum cleaner bags and sweepings
- Wallpaper and carpeting remnants
- Packaging that is not empty
- Nappies and cotton wool
- Cigarette butts and cold ashes
- Tooth- and toilet brushes
- Things made of plastic

No harmful substances

Please dispose your litter only in the bins according to the regulations. Recycling of the different sorts is only guaranteed if they are not mixed.

ORGANIC WASTE BINS

Kitchen and Garden waste

- Egg shells and leftover bread
- Cooked and raw leftovers
- Vegetables and fruit
- Coffee grounds with filter paper
- Bones
- Paper towels and newspaper
- Tea leaves and tea bags
- Spoilt food
- Grass cuttings, hedge and bush clippings
- Leaves
- Moss and weeds
- Cut flowers and potted plants
- Pet litter made of recycled paper or sawdust

Paper and cardboard

- Books, catalogues and brochures
- Notes, writing paper, exercise books
- Cardboard boxes (broken down)
- Wrapping and computer paper
- Envelopes and letters
- Newspapers and magazines

- Plastic bottles and cups
- Foamed plastic such as fruit and vegetable plates made of polystyrene

produced of mixed materials

- Juice and milk cartons
- Vacuum-packed packaging (e.g. coffee)

produced of metal

- Aluminium dishes and foil
- Food tins and beverage cans
- Metal tops from bottles and jars
